Course information

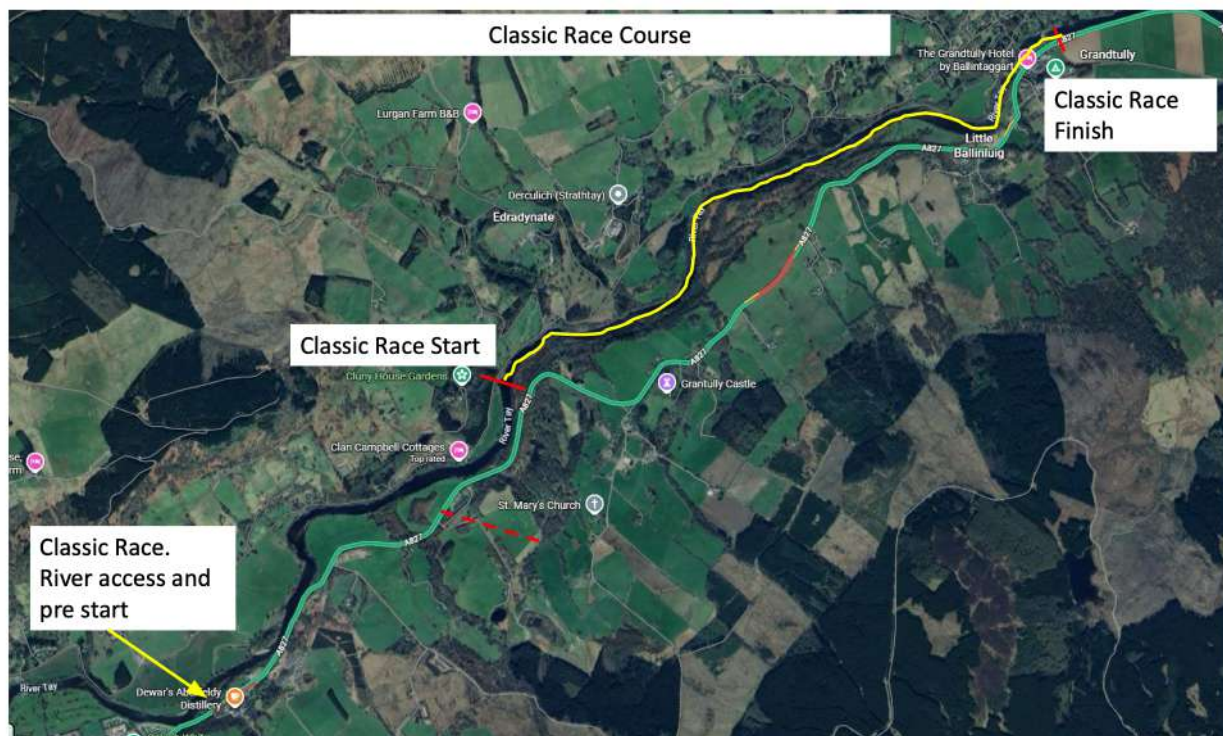
Classic

The Classic get in point will be at Beyond Adventure, Aberfeldy, with the start approximately 2kms (15-minute gentle paddle) downstream at Edradynate. The Classic course is 4.3km and consists of 8 rapid sections (grade 2-3). It will finish just after racing over 'Fourth Falls', below the bridge at Grandtully. The River Tay flows out of Loch Tay and the level of the river depends entirely on rainfall. We expect it to be low in the summer during the race however all rapids can still be navigated even with very low conditions.

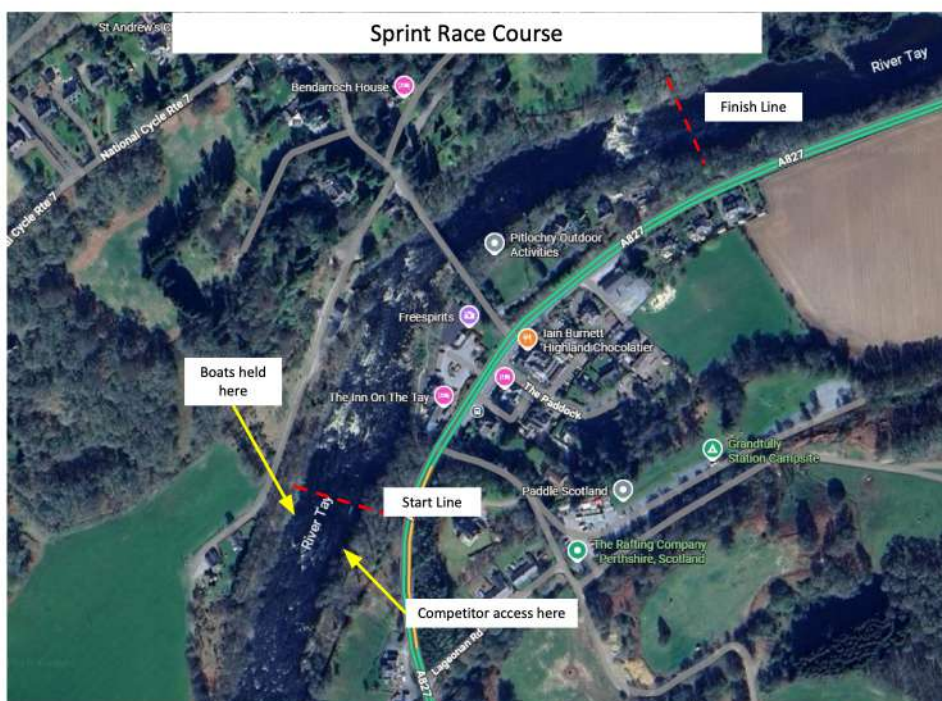
Sprint

The Sprint course will start at the top of Grandtully rapids, river left. You will be racing over the rapids, under the bridge and down to Fourth Falls. This is a 500m sprint with two rapids and a flat section in between.

Paddle Scotland Paddler Code of Conduct

Paddle Scotland have a Code of Conduct for all river users in place to ensure that everyone can share the river safely while respecting each other's use of the river. We would ask that all paddlers competing on the River Tay this August do so with respect to everyone else that is using the river, whether they be on the water or on the river bank, including fishermen.

The organisers have committed to other river users that all competitors will respect others' use of the river while training for the European Junior and U23 Wild Water Racing Championships. In return other river users have committed to give athletes unimpeded use of the river while competing. This includes people fishing who have agreed not to fish on the river between 12 – 15 August, local rafting companies who will only run rafting on agreed rafting slots during competition days, and training providers who will use other rivers while the competition is taking place.



Essential Information

Transport

Most teams will be coming over in minibuses with trailers, we expect many to travel by ferry on the Calais-Dover route. Once in the UK it will take 11-12 hour to reach Grandtully. The other ferry option is the overnight Rotterdam-Hull route which brings you into the UK further North meaning a 7-hour drive to Grandtully.

When driving in the UK with a trailer, the speed limit is 60mph, and we drive on the Left-hand side!

For family and friends coming over for the championships, there are two major airports in Scotland you can fly into – Glasgow and Edinburgh. There is good public transport at both airports which would get you easily to Perth however, the buses and trains north of Perth are not frequent so we would advise hiring cars.

Car Parking

There will be good parking areas at the event, enough for all minibuses, trailers and cars to park with plenty space round about them to allow for loading and unloading of boats. There are also areas that will have parking restrictions, as well as areas where we'll ask you not to park.

For the classic start, there is a large parking area at Beyond Adventure at Aberfeldy. However, we would ask that parking is done with consideration as Beyond Adventure will still be operating their usual business.

For the Sprint start, Classic and Sprint finish we have a very large carpark that everyone taking part in the event must use. This parking field is located at the east end of Grandtully, with the entrance being a set of double gates just before the first house. It is also located directly opposite the get out point, with pedestrian crossing lights being in place. Grandtully is a small village, any parking through the village will cause significant traffic congestion. Consequently, there will be a parking restriction in place all the way through Grandtully for the full week of the event. Sticking to this parking area and not parking in the village will ensure that we do not cause any upset in the village, and that we are welcome back for future events.

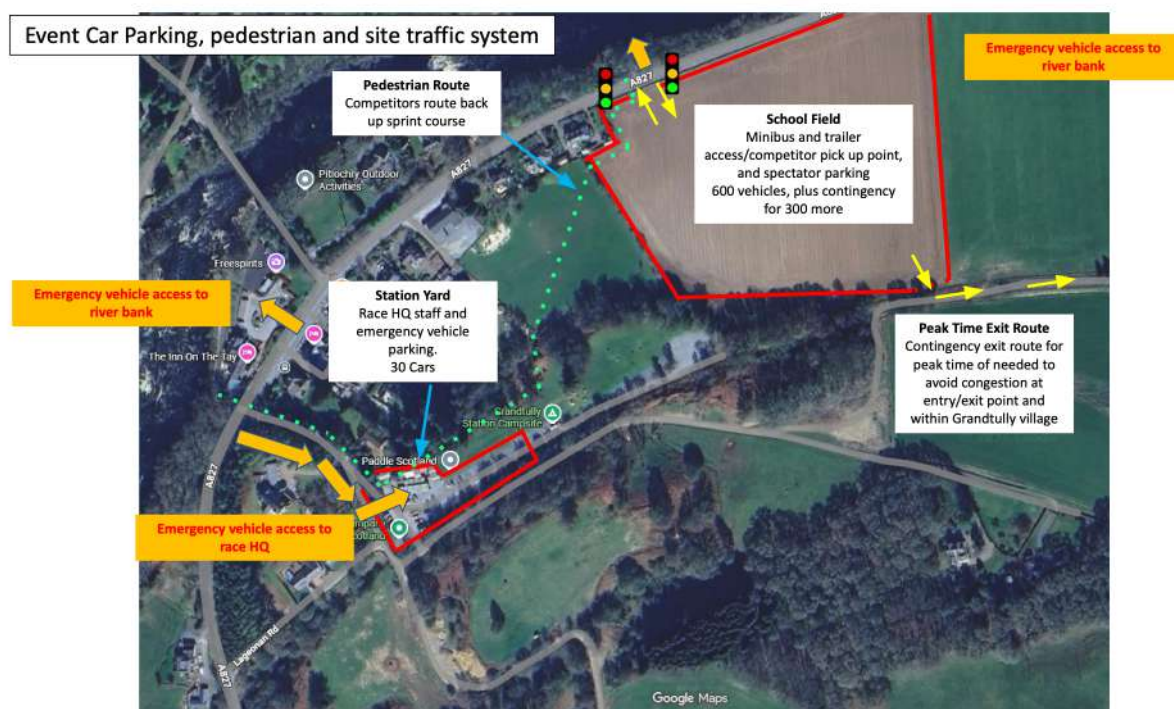


There will be toilets in the parking field, as well as a pedestrian route back to the Race Office.

There is a small car park at the Paddle Scotland Campsite and Office however, this will be reserved for officials and campsite users.

We would strongly request that everyone taking part in these Championships adhere to the parking arrangements that have been put in place. Adhering to these parking arrangements will not just ensure the smooth running of the event but ensure that future WWR events are welcome back at Grandtully.

Accommodation

Early booking of accommodation is strongly recommended as these championships will be held during a busy tourist time in Scotland.

There are multiple options for accommodation in the area around Grandtully and Aberfeldy, from hotels to apartments and campsites to community halls. With the numbers most teams need to cater for, you may be looking for places further afield, other 'bigger' villages and towns to consider include: Pitlochry, Logierait, Dunkeld and Birnam. Perth is the nearest city but would require a 40 minute drive to Grandtully. Some care should be taken with the location of the accommodation as the area has many narrow roads and steep hills that can be challenging for a mini bus and trailer.

The GB Team have booked their accommodation via Sporthotel, the contact used to help with accommodation is Louise Green louise@sportshotels.com . Louise is happy for her contact details to be shared and is willing to assist Teams with their accommodation requirements.

Catering and Food

Aberfeldy and Grandtully are small villages with no major 'supermarkets', however there is a 'Spar' in Grandtully and 'Co-op' in Aberfeldy that have all the essentials. The nearest major supermarket is in Perth, a 40 minute drive away.

Local area

Grandtully is a small village in the highlands of Scotland. It is only 10 minutes off the A9 dual carriageway making it quite accessible but also more touristy.

As it is a small village, consideration of the local community is absolutely required to preserve the good will that we need to run this and future events. Organisers have been in discussion with local landowners to provide additional access and parking as well as safe routes to and from the river, so please stick to the designated parking and access ways.

The Grandtully Village Hall, has been hired for the duration of the event. The Village Hall will be used for all Team Manager Meetings, also should teams want to use the hall for their own meetings then this can be arranged via the Race Office.

There is a large field at the back of the Village Hall, there is a stretch tent in the field. Competitors can use this as a shelter if required.
